- Mr. Russell Coleman SC** – Mr. Russell Coleman SC was the Chairman of the Bar Council of the Hong Kong Bar Association in 2009 and 2010. He was called to the Bar of England and Wales by the Honorable Society of the Inner Temple in 1986. He moved to live and work in Hong Kong in 1990, and was admitted to full practice at the Hong Kong Bar in 1991. He practises from Temple Chambers, and enjoys a broad practice in civil and commercial law. He took ‘Silk’ in 2006.
- Mr. Coleman is a Chartered Arbitrator, has published various articles, and edited texts, on arbitration, and is frequently appointed as arbitrator, in domestic and international arbitrations. He is a past President of the Hong Kong Institute of Arbitrators, a Council Member of the Hong Kong International Arbitration Centre (HKIAC) and a CEDR Accredited Mediator.
- Mr. Robin Egerton** – Mr. Robin Egerton was admitted as a solicitor in England and Hong Kong in 1984 and ceased to be a practising solicitor in March 2004. He has acted as an Ad Hoc Deputy District Judge. He has been involved in mediation since 1996 and has been an accredited Mediator with the Hong Kong International Arbitration Centre (HKIAC) since 2002. He was called to the Hong Kong Bar in August 2004 and appointed to the Bar Council in March 2006. In April 2008 he was appointed as the Vice-Chairman of the Accreditation and Training Sub-group of the Secretary for Justice’s Working Group on Mediation. In 2009 he became a CEDR accredited mediator.
