He has involved in a great number of mediation and arbitration cases related to Construction, Property, Import/Export, Telecommunication, Loan Agreement, and Shareholders' Disputes. In addition to Prof. Leung's position as Founding President and Governor of the Hong Kong Mediation Centre and Founding President of Institute of International Experts. Prof. Leung also appointed as Adjunct Professor of School of Law at City University of Hong Kong, Adjunct Professor and teaches 'Dispute Resolution for Engineers' at HKUST. He has promoted and provided training of mediation/arbitration for over 20 years. Prof. Leung is a member of the Working Party for the Reform of the Law of Arbitration in Hong Kong and draft Arbitration Bill; Mediation Task Force; and was on the Law Reform Committee on Conditional fee. He is General Editor of "Hong Kong Mediation Handbook" and "China Arbitration Handbook" and Chief Editor of the HKMC Journal on Mediation. He has also edited and authored many prominent publications in relation to mediation and arbitration in Hong Kong.
