Mr. David Fong is a Barrister of the High Court of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region. He was awarded the degree of Master of Laws (Maritime and Transportation Law) with Distinction by the City University of Hong Kong. He is also a Chartered Certified Accountant, a Certified Public Accountant and a Certified Tax Advisor in Hong Kong. As a Fellow of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators, he has been admitted to the panel of arbitrators at various arbitral institutions in Asia.

David is both an Accredited Mediator and Assessor of the HKMAAL. He joined the Accredited Mediator (General) panel of the HKIAC in 2005 and has been practiced as a commercial mediator since then. He was a Director of the Joint Mediation Helpline Office from 2010-2012 and is at present its Honorary Treasurer.

He is also acting as a mediation coach in certain non-profit organisations.
